THE PLAYER WILL:

1. Play fairly and have fun.
2. Abide by the rules set down by the team managers when traveling to away events.
3. Behave in a manner that avoids bringing the sport and club into disrepute.
4. Respect officials and accept their decisions.
5. Talk to the children's officer if you have concerns.
6. Respect opponents and always give kind gestures at the end of a match (no hand shake, COVID Guide).
7. Use his/her best efforts in competitive matches.
8. Refrain from the use of bad language and inappropriate gestures.
9. Refrain from abuse of sports equipment.
10. Never use unfair or bullying tactics to gain advantage on or off the floor (playing area).
11. Never use bullying tactics to isolate another player or adult.
12. Never pass on gossip about another player or adult.
13. Never make false allegations about another player or adult.
14. Never keep secrets about anyone who has caused you harm physically or emotionally.
15. Win with grace and lose with dignity.

PARENT/GUARDIAN'S CODE OF CONDUCT

PARENTS/GUARDIANS ARE EXPECTED:

1. Acknowledge the importance and role of the club coaches who often provide their time free to ensure children's participation in the club.
2. Show appreciation and support the Club Staff
3. Deliver and collect the child punctually to and from coaching sessions/matches
4. Ensure their child is properly and adequately attired for the weather conditions of the time, including shorts, shirts, socks, tracksuits, sweat-tops, hat, gloves, etc.
5. Ensure that proper footwear and protective equipment are worn at All times in accordance with Health and safety Regulations. Any child not in possession of the fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate.
6. Detail any health concern pertaining to the child on the consent form, in particular breathing or chest conditions for Covid-19 these are serious health risk. Any changes in the state of child's health should be reported to the Club manager and coach in writing via a form of email. This should be done before the next practice session.
7. To inform the coach prior to departure from the field of play if child is to be collected early from coaching session.
8. Encourage their child to play by the rules and teach them that they can only do their best i.e. focus on effort rather than performance.
9. Behave responsibly on the sideline.
10. Inform the coach if child will be going home via Uber or other adults not family member. Provide individual's car registration and full name.
11. Be realistic
12. Provide their child with proper clothing and equipment.
13. Ensure their child's hygiene and nutritional needs are met.
14. Accept the official's judgment.
15. Promote their child's participation in playing sport for fun.
16. Not ignore or dismiss complaints expressed by a child.
17. Not treat the club as a minding service.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- Know their child is safe.
- Be informed if their child is injured.
- Contribute to decisions within the club.
- Be informed of problems or concerns relating to their children.
- Have their consent for issues such as trips.
- Complain if they have concerns about the standard of coaching.

Any misdemeanors and breach of this Code of Conduct will be dealt with immediately by the club official. Persistent concerns or breaches will result in the parent/Guardian being asked not to attend games if their attendance is detrimental to the child's welfare. The ultimate action should a parent/guardian continue to breach

the code of behavior may mean the Westcliff Eagles Basketball club officials regrettably asking the child to leave the club.
